The main text, like the author names, used Times New Roman font, 14 points for the Author names and 12 points for the remainder of the abstract. Type or paste your text into this file, but remember to keep the page margins the same as is set here which is 2.5 cm all round. Paragraphs are justified (straight-edged) on both left and right.

Use single-line spacing and leave a line gap between paragraphs. This helps your text to be read easily. The abstract deadline depends on when you register. There is no fee for submission of an abstract, but if you do not register and pay the outstanding registration fee in full by the deadline according to your LoA and Invoice, the abstract will not be accepted.

We will send a formal acceptance (LoA) and Invoice of your abstract in order to be funded to come to the conference. Please write this in your email when you submit your abstract and you will receive a prompt reply.

The organizers expect that there will be more abstracts submitted with preference for exhibition than can be accommodated in the program. They will inform those who submit abstracts and will aim to do so by May. Please note that there will be ample time into the conference schedule.

The limit for your abstract is one page. Abstracts that do not meet these formatting requirements will be returned. The organizing committee reserves the right to edit abstracts for clarity or correctness of English, but will consult the author if any significant changes are needed. The abstract format is also written in participants guideline, please check it either.
